Meeting of the Northeast High-Level Radioactive Waste Transportation Task Force 2021 Fall Meeting October 27-28, 2021 at the Sofitel Philadelphia at Rittenhouse Square Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

The fall meeting of the Northeast High-Level Radioactive Waste Transportation Task Force was held October 27-28 at the Sofitel Philadelphia at Rittenhouse Square in Pennsylvania. Co-chair Jerry Humphreys was not present at the meeting so the meeting was chaired by Co-chair Wade DeHaas of Pennslyvania. Seven of the ten northeast states were represented with the exceptions of Delaware, New Hampshire, and Maine. Also at this meeting were representatives from the DOE, other SRGs, and members of the TRMTC, and presenters to the Task Force.

The meeting began with opening remarks and introductions by Co-chair Wade Dehaas. Staff noted to the Task Force that some members could not be present in person at this meeting so a conference call phone was set-up for the entirety of the meeting. Staff noted to the Task Force that Wade Dehaas' term as a co-chair is up for election at this meeting and since a quarum was present a vote can be held. Wade Dehaas was the only candidate nominated for consideration, and a vote was held where his election was unanimous. Wade Dehaas will serve as a co-chair for the next two years (fall 2021 to fall 2023).
