She is an expert in public health preparedness and previously served as Baltimore's Health Commissioner. A contributing columnist for *The Washington Post*, Dr. Wen is a frequent guest commentator on the COVID-19 crisis on CNN, MSNBC, and BBC. In 2019, she was named one of *Modern Healthcare's* Top 50 Physician-Executives and *TIME* magazine's 100 Most Influential People.

Lisa Simpson is President and CEO of AcademyHealth. A nationally recognized health policy researcher and pediatrician, she is a passionate advocate for the translation of research into policy and practice. Her research, articles, and commentaries in peer reviewed journals focus on the role of evidence and data to improve health and healthcare, particularly for children and vulnerable populations. Dr. Simpson also serves on the board of directors of the Institute for Accountable Care and the National Health Council. Previously, she was Professor of Pediatrics, and the first endowed Chair in child health policy at the University of South Florida. She served as the Deputy Director of the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality from 1996 to 2002. In 2013, Dr. Simpson was elected to the National Academy of Medicine.
