Senator Louis P. DiPalma represents District 12, Little Compton, Middletown, Newport, and Tiverton, Rhode Island. He is married to Margaret and they have two children. He is employed as a Technical Director for Raytheon. A graduate Notre Dame Catholic High School, he went on to earn a B.S. in Computer Engineering from the University of Bridgeport and a M.S. in Computer Science from Brown University.
