Avesta Housing is the largest nonprofit affordable housing provider in northern New England.


Founded in 1972, Avesta's mission is to improve lives and strengthen communities by promoting and providing quality affordable homes for people in need.



# Affordable homes in rural communities

- ~30% of Avesta
   Housing's portfolio is
   in rural communities in
   Maine and New
   Hampshire
- 15 of those properties were built using USDA Rural Development funding

# **Challenges**

- Aging housing stock
- Increasing construction costs (supplies & labor)
- Low rents and inadequate resources for development
- Restrictive zoning
- NIMBYism
- Limited access to transit, services, amenities



## **Potential Solutions**

- State, Municipal land disposition
- Funding tools (MaineHousing's Rural Rental Program, CDBG, Tax Increment Financing, Affordable Housing Trust)
- Land use & design tools (zoning, code)
- Partnerships municipalities & regional orgs, businesses & other anchor institutions, transit providers

## Fryeburg, Maine

- 28 new homes for 55+
- Key partnerships with Town of Fryeburg and SMPDC (regional planning org)
- Sources: 4% LIHTC; State tax credits, subsidy, and debt; FHLB Boston and EPA brownfields grants; projectbased vouchers; solar tax credits
- Completed January 2024
